- The last day for filing Nomination Papers is Friday, September 10, 2010 **Between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.**
- Nominations must be filed on the prescribed form and be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
- Nomination forms and further information is available at the Town Office.
- Nomination Paper can be filed for one of the following:
 - Mayor
 - Deputy Mayor
 - Councillor (5 to be elected)
- Nomination Paper can be filed at the City of Woodstock for the following:
 - English Language Public School Board (2 tentative)
 - English Language Separate School Board (1 tentative)
 - Conseil Scholaire de District des Ecoles Catholiques du Sud-Ouest (1 Tentative)
- Nomination Paper can be filed at the Town of Ingersoll, on behalf of the Municipality of chatham-Kent
 - Conseil Scholaire Public de District du Centre Sud-Ouest – 1 Position
