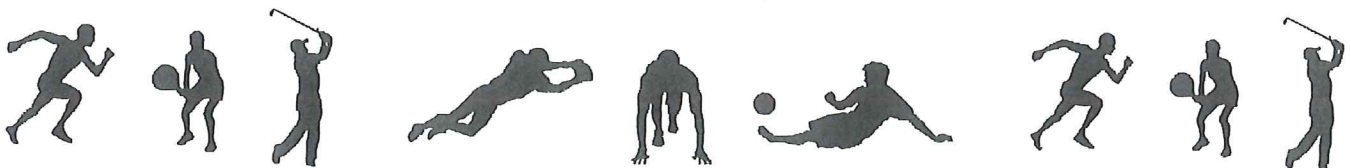

- 3 Illuminated showcase with 2 puck lights per showcaseinset into graphic panels: QTY 4, 2'H x 2'W x 2'D  
QTY 4, 2'H x 4'W x 2'D

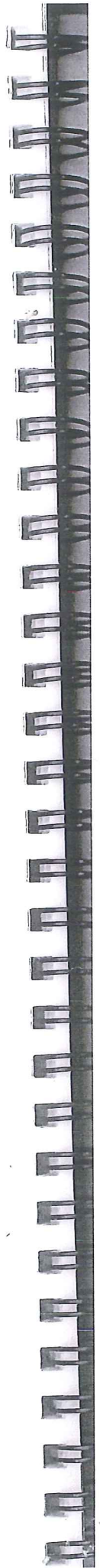
