MAINTENANCE

The annual Spring Cleanup program ended May 15th with a total of 335,330 kg (243,640 kg 2007) of material taken to landfill. We have not received the totals for the steel collected during the cleanup.

The first grass cutting for all roadsides is now complete. The next cut is scheduled for mid June.

Line painting operations did not commence until May 21st this season due to the numerous rain days. We anticipate, weather permitting, that all lines will be painted the week of June 9th.

All streets have been swept once through out the Town and the sweeper has been switched over and is currently cleaning basins. The Board of Health has not yet given us a schedule for West Nile treatment.

ADMINISTRATIVE

Considerable time was spent reviewing the 102 applications for the full time Public Works position to replace Donald Teichrob. Interviews were conducted on 6 applicants with Ryan Krienselokker the successful applicant. Ryan brings experience to the department from the building and construction trade.

We have hire George Gerantonis as a casual employee until Rob Winlaw recovers from knee surgery. Rob expects to be off three to six months after his surgery.

Once again considerable time was spent dealing with Spring Clean up/Large Article Pick up questions and issues. No matter how much advertising we do, we always seem to receive these questions.

Other duties included By-Law Review, Budget, Shared Services and Waste Management meetings.
