1. Advertising fee in the amount of \$214.70 to cover the cost of advertising this application in the Ingersoll Times. Please make cheque or money order payable to the Minister of Finance. A public notice placard will be forwarded under separate cover to post at the establishment for 30 days.
2. Does the Applicant rent, lease or own the premises? If he rents or leases, please provide the landlord's name.
3. Question 14 of the Personal History Report requires an explanation.
4. In checking with Companies and Personal Property Security Branch it was noted that there is no business name registered to 1768370 Ontario Inc. You must register the name under the Business Name Act and forward a copy of the Master Business Licence to this office. 5. Re-submit two copies of the floor plan on 8 1/2" x 11" papers. Each of the licensed areas must be clearly outlined.
6. Municipal Information form completed by the City or Town Clerk.

7. Letters of compliance from the Building, Fire and Health Departments. **IMPORTANT! Compliance letters are only valid for one year from their date of issuance.** If occupancy loads are not assigned by Building or Fire, you will have to have your premise plans stamped and signed by an architect or engineer, with them assigning an occupancy load directly on the plan. <http://www.agco.on.ca/pdf/forms/O122E.pdf>
8. You must complete and submit the attached "Notification of Completion of Premises Suitable for Liquor Inspection" in order that a licensing inspection may be scheduled in a timely manner.


Please note that the completion of the licensing inspection does not guarantee an immediate issuance of a liquor licence. You must continue to submit all outstanding documents and information requested by the Licensing Officer or, if applicable, an investigator, to complete your application.

Please submit items numbered 1-5 within 15 days of the date of this letter in order to complete the processing of your application.

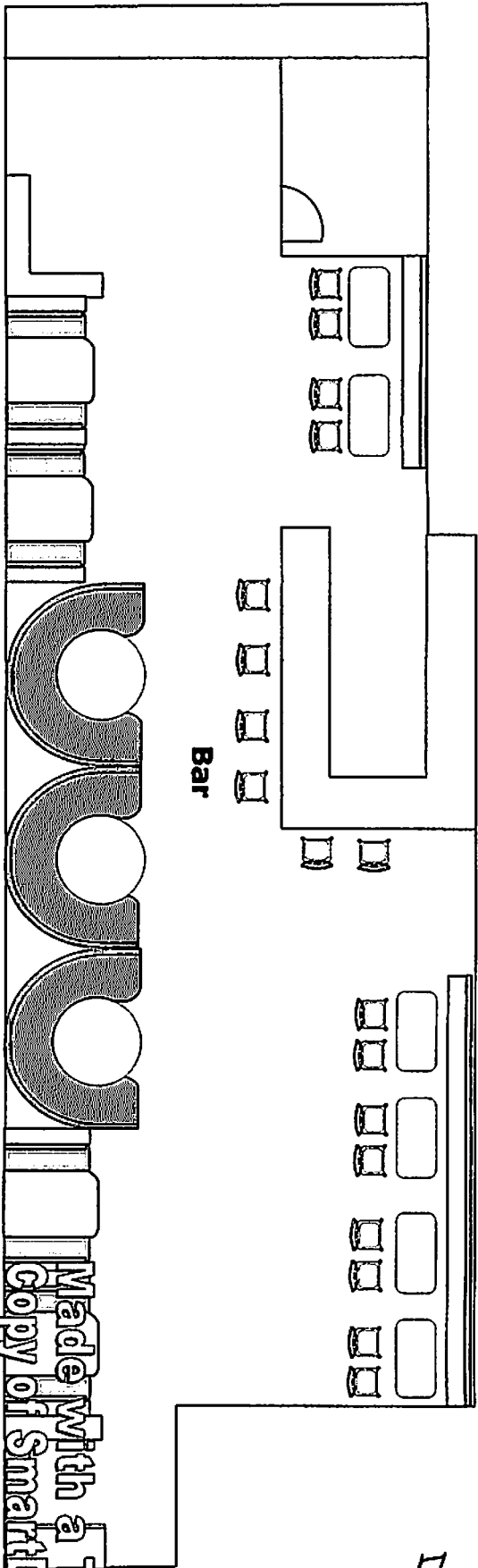
