MAINTENANCE

The annual Spring Large Item Pickup program ended with a total of 201,379 kg of material taken to the landfill. We have not received the totals for the steel collected during the cleanup.

Line Painting operations have been delayed this season due to paint supply problem. The low bidder could not supply the proper paint so the second bidder was awarded the tender. This operation will begin the first two weeks of June.

Basin cleaning operations have started with anticipation of this operation being put on hold early July for treatment of West Nile.

Other activities included sign repairs, stump repairs, utility cut restoration, grass cutting and sweeping.

ADMINISTRATIVE

Once again considerable time was spent dealing with issues relating to the Large Item Pickup program. We encountered quite a few households that set out the wrong materials and/or in a manner that made it unacceptable to collect.

All sidewalks and streets have been patrolled to locate priority areas for the summer concrete and asphalt programs.

Other duties included Shared Services, By-Law Review, Management, Waste Management and Site Plan meeting. The writer also attended a "Green Fleet Expo" in Burlington. There were various speakers covering items of interest such as alternate fuels, bio diesel, hybrid vehicles and fuel conservation programs.
