MAINTENANCE

Line painting operations are complete with the exception of construction and resurfacing areas. Weather has not cooperated for these activities.

Roadsides have been cut for the second time this season with the exception of Ingersoll Street Extension. Due to construction operations by C.R.U. we have not been able to cut this area.

Staff has been busy cleaning catch basins before their treatment for West Nile. The treatment is scheduled for mid July.

Repairs have been started on the 35 manholes scheduled for this summer. These operations will run through the entire month of July.

All utility cuts that were done during the winter months have now been repaired. These locations required asphaltting, concrete and top soiling to complete.

ADMINISTRATIVE

Considerable time was spent with staff scheduling maintenance priorities for asphaltting, catch basins, and manhole and sidewalk repairs. As always, there are more maintenance needs than funding.

June was a busy month for meetings and conferences with the following being attended: IAPA Regional Conference, AORS, Health and Safety, Management and Shared Services meeting, Collective Agreement Contract negotiations with CUPE 107 and attending the AORS Trade Show in Leamington.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

Quantities from the steel collection during the Large Article Pickup were received from Core Industries. A total of 90,640 lbs. was collected which is up from 46,060 lbs. in 2008. Once again the low price for scrap steel is the reason for the higher quantities.
