To whom it may concern:

The Sacred Heart Church is requesting that the street in front of Sacred Heart Church be closed to traffic on Friday Oct. 16 from 10:30 am until approximately 1:30 pm. There will be a memorial Mass for the pioneers whose remains were disinterred on John Street. There will be approximately 106 pine containers holding the remains loaded on to two farm wagons starting after the memorial mass which will start at 10:00. The wagons will be in position on the street in front of the church prior to the conclusion of the mass. (approximately 10:30) The wagons will be horse drawn. If this is not feasible, then they will be drawn by pickup trucks. The wagons will then go in procession at a walking speed with the pall bearers and perhaps other parishioners to the Catholic Cemetery. We also request that the route from Sacred Heart Church to the cemetery be closed to vehicular traffic during the procession. We anticipate arrival at the cemetery gate at or before 1:30 pm. The route will be from 131 Thames Street, north to North Town Line, east on North Town Line to Hampden Street and north on Hampden to the entrance of the cemetery.
