My husband and I are residents on "McKeand St.", where the proposed name change is to take place.

We have lived here less than a year and have just had to change all of our identification to reflect our new address and now you want us to do it again. Although most changes do not cost anything, it is inconvenient and time consuming. Not all of our changes can be made online, some require you to go in person, others you have to mail in, either way it costs a stamp or time off work.

If the issue is that McKeand Street will be "cut up", what is the worry? Wonham St. continues on the other side of the river and Ingersoll St. was divided for a number of years prior to the erection of the new bridge. A number of Ontario cities/towns have streets that start on one side of town and continue on another. Thamesford has Delatre St. east and west of the river, London has streets that do the same.

A fence has been erected at the tracks, new asphalt has been put down and our taxes have been increased (even though no upgrades have happened at our end of the street).
