Dear Elaine,

As a resident of Feltz Drive in Ingersoll, I have concerns about the Recreational Vehicle Parking Bylaw as do some of our neighbors. We will appear before council if necessary but are more than happy to use correspondence if that is acceptable.

Here are our concerns;

1. The RV Parking By-law is not enforced in the whole town of Ingersoll therefore we feel it is discriminatory to those of us who live on Feltz Drive.
2. We have been parking our RV's on our property for the last 8 years and now are being forced to look elsewhere for parking at a considerable cost to us.
3. There is no accessible secured parking facility in or within a reasonable distance to Ingersoll where we could park.
4. If the complaint was about us, what was the exact complaint and if not, and it was made about someone in our area, why are we being given notice.
5. RV's may be parked at our place of residence until the situation has been resolved.

Possible resolutions;

1. Parking for the summer season (May long weekend - Thanksgiving) as long as the vehicle is in the driveway and not impeding on streets or sidewalks
2. Limit (1) RV per household
3. All vehicles will be parked in the driveway and not on the road to make room for an RV.
4. RV will be in good working order and not appear as an abandoned vehicle.

If we are to appear before council there may be a number of residents who wish to speak. I list of their names will be given before the deadline if that is required. If you need a separate letter from each individual please let me know and I will pass it along. Thank you, in advance for addressing our concerns.
