

Dear Mr. Paul Hollbrough;

For 2 years I have tried to get council to make a fencing by-law that would cover the parameters of privacy fencing between properties. I actually faxed in a letter 2 years ago to Elaine re this matter.

The reality is that my neighbour Mr Heald at 140 Bell St has been harassing us by first putting in a privacy fence that not only blocks our view at 134 Bell Street but takes away from the enjoyment of our home. He has done this because we insisted that he stop encroaching on our property by planting vegetation right up next to our house. I erected a chain link fence along the west side of our house to define our boundary line and stop any disagreements. His response was to erect a very high privacy fence. Recently he did damage to my driveway. When I broached him to fix it he ignored so I called in my insurance company.

His response was to extend the privacy fence
up to the town line blocking my view of the
street.

I am aware that you now have a by-law
pertaining to privacy fencing. I would appreciate
it if this could be enacted at your next
meeting which I believe is on May 17/10. It
at all possible could it be back dated to the time
it was originally created.
