I am sorry for not getting this to you sooner, In the case of the access to Lorne Moon Park from Mcmillan crt. This is to confirm a verbal mention of this subject to you.

When the present sidewalk was installed I made an inquiry to I believe it was Dan from the Parks dept. He spoke to me and said he would look into it.

I have since made a similiar mention to someone at the city desk who said at the time that she may be involved with the clerks department or would make my concerns available to you.

this was during the summer possibly august or september.

The sidewalk has been there for almost a year and the access and egress is limited by two items.

The first item is an obvious three foot high berm at the end of the sidewalk with a pice of scrap wood covering it because of the mud I presume.

The second item is the egress is even more unsafe because as one comes off of the high ground there is a drain cover with very large openings just waiting for a foot to get entangled in it.

The injury caused by this open grate and high berm would sadly be applied to the liability insurance that the city carries for such indiscretions.

I understand there are mitigating problems with the developers of this site but i feel since the city has had prior knowledge of it that the liability sits squarely with the city of Ingersoll,

and I would hope that this matter would be looked after with expediency.

It should also be mentioned that this limits access to the facility by the elderly, the mothers with carriages and those that require wheeled access,

this is a public facility and should not be restricted to any of its memebers by physical barriers.

I will keep a copy of this notice and willingly supply it to anyone who gets injured at this site.
