RE: **Tax Refunds and Abatements/Supplementary Levies/Payments in Lieu of Taxes (PIL'S)**

---

**RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT, the attached schedule(s) of property taxes be approved by Council of the Town of Ingersoll for cancellation, reduction and/or refund, supplementary and payment billing.

**BACKGROUND:**

In accordance with Section 357 of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, C.25 an application to the Council may be made for cancellation, reduction and refund of taxes for the following reasons:

- Ceased to be liable to be taxed at rate it was taxed
- The land becomes vacant land during the year or preceding year
- Became Exempt
- Razed by fire, demolition or otherwise
- Damaged by fire, demolition or otherwise (substantially unusable)
- Mobile unit removed
- Gross or manifest clerical error
- Repairs/renovations preventing normal use for a period of 3 months

Application may be made at any time during the year and until February 28 of the following year. The attached listing (s) is for all applications received in 2009 for the current and prior years.

Under Section 353 (3) of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, the municipality is allowed to charge back a proportionate share of taxes to the School Boards, County and Business Improvement Area.

The attached schedule of Tax Refunds/Abatements indicates the components by function. The principal amount of \$55,622.64 is the responsibility of the Town of Ingersoll and is inclusive of 357 applications, ARB approved changes, vacancy rebates, minutes of settlement and municipal grants, as approved. The approved Budget for 2009 is \$100,000.

The attached schedule of Supplementary Levies indicates the components by function for supplementary and payments in lieu. The combined principal amount of \$106,747.67 is the portion levied on behalf of the Town of Ingersoll. The approved (combined) Budget for 2009 is \$160,584.
