General Motors has announced an additional \$560 million investment package for the CAMI Assembly plant in Ingersoll. This investment will prepare the facility for the manufacturing of the next generation Chevrolet Equinox through \$190mn invested directly at the facility and \$370mn in supplier tooling investments.
