



**CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INGERSOLL
BY-LAW NO. 03-4096**

**A by-law to authorize the dispersal of assets upon the
dissolution of Ingersoll Cheese Factory Museum.**

WHEREAS the Town of Ingersoll remains committed to preserving and maintaining the museum as it is a valuable educational and tourism asset to the Town. The preservation of our heritage is a source of pride for the local residents.

AND WHEREAS the building and artifact collection of the Ingersoll Cheese Factory Museum are the property of the Corporation of the Town of Ingersoll.

AND WHEREAS a resolution to dissolve the said museum would be the responsibility of Ingersoll Town Council/Museum Board.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Town of Ingersoll enacts as follows:

- (1) Artifacts on loan or lease or those artifacts which have special arrangements made for their return to the donor family would be addressed as to instructions provided.
- (2) Non profit incorporated museums in Oxford County would be given the first choice of the remaining artifacts for accession into their respective collections.
- (3) Other qualified non profit museums outside the Oxford County boundary would be allowed to choose from the remaining artifacts for accession into their respective collections.
- (4) Dispersal of the remaining artifacts would be through auction with the proceeds being the property of the Town of Ingersoll.
- (5) Museum staff, members of the board or volunteers would not be eligible to receive artifacts being disposed.
- (6) The Town of Ingersoll agrees to the repayment of outstanding museum liabilities such as outstanding grants, staff salaries, and other accounts payable.

READ a third time and passed this 9th day of June 2003.
