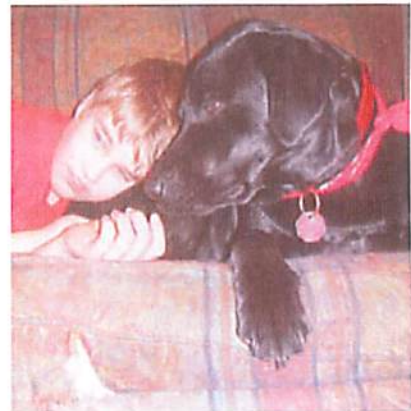

The Kiwanis Club of Ingersoll has served the greater Oxford County and beyond since its incorporation on April 21, 1921. Its focal point has been Young Children Priority One and, as a member of Kiwanis International, pledges to "serve the children of the world." The Club continues to contribute to many local needs, including Alexandra Hospital, the Fusion Youth Centre, Camp Hope, Citizenship Awards, scholarships for local students, the Breakfast Program, sports programs, ITOPA, the Ingersoll Library, Scouting, Easter Seals Ontario and the Children's Hospital of Western Ontario.

The proceeds from the 2010 Kiwanis Chip-in-Fore-Kids Golf Tournament will be split evenly between the Thames Valley Children's Centre and the purchase of a specially trained companion dog for an autistic child in Ingersoll. The cost of purchasing a companion dog is approximately \$16,000. This year's dog is called Pepsi and is presently training with his special needs child. Previously, the Kiwanis Club has participated in the purchase of a companion dog, "Boomer", for Todd Alves and another dog, "Beau", for David Gifford. The positive impact these dogs have upon the child and the entire family has been extremely rewarding.



The Kiwanis Club of Ingersoll has been a tremendous supporter of the Thames Valley Children's Centre (TVCC) over the past 16 years, committing over \$137,000 to help the clients reach beyond disability. In collaboration with the TVCC and, in light of the Kiwanis motto, Young Children Priority One, the Kiwanis Club of Ingersoll is hosting a golf tournament to raise funds to assist the TVCC and the more than 730 children in Oxford County that use TVCC's facilities and services. The Chip-in-Fore-Kids Golf Tournament will take place at the Ingersoll Golf and Country Club on Monday, October 4th.
