## **Suggested subjects for poems:**

Your poem may be on any subject. Cheese poems and dairy odes; the Town of Ingersoll today; the history of Ingersoll; famous people of Ingersoll. In 2010, an award will be given for the best poem about the Ingersoll Pipe Band in honour of their 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

## **Categories of poetry for the contest:**

Rhyming verse, Limerick, Haiku, Free verse, Acrostic, Longer Poems, Other

- Deadline for entries is Friday October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 – 4 p.m.
- Entries must be typed, word processed, or neatly printed on the entry form.
- One person may enter up to three poems

All entries must be the original creation of the submitting author.

The decision of the judges is final.
