NOTICE OF PESTICIDE USE

Between **July 2 and September 30, 2008** the Oxford County Public Health and Emergency Services will be conducting a larviciding program under the authority of the Local Acting Medical Officer of Health to control larval mosquitoes in order to prevent their development into vectors of West Nile virus. The ingot formulation of the larvicide methoprene, *Altosid XR Briquets*, PCP # 27694 will be placed into catch basins of storm drains in the **Town of Ingersoll**. *VectoLex WSP*, PCP # 28009 will be placed into Environmentally Sensitive catch basins. The larvicide *VectoLex CG*, PCP # 28008 may be placed into standing water if surveillance indicates that treatments are warranted.

All larvicide will be applied by Ministry of Environment licensed applicators or trained technicians.
