Ingersoll Police Services Board

Overview

The Ingersoll Police Services Board (PSB) is required under the *Police Services Act* as a result of the Town's contract with O.P.P. The Board's responsibilities are established under section 31 of the Act and includes aiding the detachment commander in determining objectives and priorities for local police services.

Terms of Reference

To assist the Town of Ingersoll in assuring compliance with the *Police Services Act*.

Composition

By-law 07-4350 approved increasing membership on the PSB from three to five members. Composition of the five-member Board is established under the Police Services Act and detailed below:

The Ingersoll Police Services Board is composed of five members; the Mayor of the Town of Ingersoll (or another member of Council if the Mayor chooses not to be a member of the Board); one Council member appointed by resolution; one person appointed by resolution of Council, who is neither a member of the Council nor an employee of the municipality; and two persons appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
