All net proceeds of the face masks sold (\$20 per unit) will be donated to assist long-term care workers in the community. Items will be sold via curbside pick-up and through contactless payment (debit/credit).

GOOD NEWS ITEM: ONTARIO TO FURTHER EASE RESTRICTIONS

The Ontario government is allowing all retail stores with a street entrance to provide curbside pick-up and delivery, as well as, in-store payment and purchases at garden centres, nurseries, hardware stores and safety supply stores. Business owners are strongly encouraged to review the health and safety guidelines developed by the province.

As early as Friday May 8, garden centres and nurseries will be able to open for in-store payment and purchases, operating under the same guidelines as grocery stores and pharmacies. Hardware stores and safety supply stores will be permitted to open for in-store payment and purchases as soon as Saturday May 9. On Monday May 11, retail stores with a street entrance can begin offering curbside pick-up and delivery, in accordance with the Ministry of Health's Guidance Document for Essential Workplaces and occupational health and safety requirements.

Businesses must follow public health measures and show review the workplace safety guidelines, such as promoting physical distancing and frequent hand-washing, sanitizing surfaces, installing physical barriers, staggering shifts and using contactless payment options to stop the spread of COVID-19.
