Membership Cancellation Policy

Cancellation of auto renewing monthly fitness membership requires a minimum of 30-days' notice and must be submitted in writing to the front desk. Upon receipt of your cancellation notice, your next scheduled payment will be considered your final payment.

Non-Sufficient Funds

Declined/NSF payments will be charge an NSF fee of \$25.00. The repayment must be paid by cash, debit or certified cheque. Participation in any Town of Ingersoll and Community Services Department activity will also be suspended until payment is received. The Town of Ingersoll and Community Services Department reserves the right to terminate client/membership privileges, without refund, for an account overdue more than 30 days.

Membership Cards

They are non-refundable and non-transferable. Membership cards cannot be loaned to another individual. For all lost, stolen or damaged cards, a \$2.50 replacement fee will apply. Cards must be presented at each visit.

Refund Policy

Cancelling BEFORE session starts entitles patrons to a REFUND minus a \$20 admin fee or full amount paid can sit on your client account to be used towards future programming. Cancelling AFTER session starts (as defined by minimum 1 class occurred) entitles clients to CREDIT ON ACCOUNT minus the cost of services provided or classes attended.

Transfer Policy

Patrons are able to request a transfer between courses. We will do our best to accommodate all requests based on course availability, course pre requisites and instructor availability. If the course you are registering IN is MORE expensive then the course you are transferring OUT of, you are responsible to pay the difference before you can participate in class. IF the course you are registering IN is LESS expensive than the course you are transferring OUT of, we will leave the remaining balance on your client account to be used towards future programming.

Weight Room

No person(s) under the age of 12 shall be permitted to access the Fitness Centre. Youth between the ages of 12-13 must register, participate in and successfully complete the Pre-teen orientation with a Personal Trainer in order to use the Fitness Centre. Youth 12-13yrs must be supervised by a guardian 18+ years at all times while in the fitness centre. Person(s) of 14 years of age and older are permitted with valid membership to access the Fitness Centre.

Financial Assistance

Victoria Park Community Pool Admission Standards Apply to ALL Open Swims

RED BAND - 5 Years of Age or Under

- Children 5 years of age or under may not be admitted to the swimming pool unless they are accompanied by a parent/guardian who is responsible for their direct in-water, same area of the pool, within arm's reach, supervision.
- One parent/guardian required per two children.
- Children may wear a lifejacket but the ratio remains 1:2.

YELLOW BAND - 6 - 9 Years

- Yellow bands are to be worn by children who are between 6 and 9 years of age.
- Must be accompanied by a parent/guardian who is responsible for their direct in-water, same area of the pool, within arm's reach, supervision.
- Ratio is one parent/guardian to four children.
- Ratio may be increased to one parent/guardian to eight children when all children are yellow banded and wearing a lifejacket. *in-water, within arm's reach, same area of pool applies.

GREEN BAND - 6 - 11 Years

- Children 6-9 years of age must be yellow banded and then take the swim test as soon as they come out to the pool. Those who are able to pass the facility swim test may be admitted to the pool and the parent/guardian must be in the water.
- Children 6-9 who do not pass the facility swim test must wear their yellow band and are subject to the yellow band parameters as listed above.
- Swim test = swim 2 widths of the pool with face in the water using a comfortable breathing pattern, arm and leg action, no stopping or touching the bottom of the pool or the lane rope. All swim tests are done in the shallow end and the Lifeguard makes the final decision.
- Children 6-9 years of age will be required to take the facility swim test each visit if they want to receive a green band.
- 10-11 years of age may be admitted to the pool unaccompanied, no swim test required, green band required. Parent/Guardian must remain in the building.

NO BAND REQUIRED - 12 Years+

- 12+ years of age considered as a guardian in the pool, no swim test, no band required.
- Guardians are responsible for the children in their care while in the facility. Supervision is defined as the direct in-water, same area of the pool, within arm's reach, supervision.

RZone
