Mandate

Objectives and Goals

- Maintain the Town's 'Bronze' Bicycle-Friendly status.
- Review the "Complete Streets Policy" (By-Law 16-4890)
- Advocate for the inclusion of cycling when undertaking community planning.
- Work with the Recreational Trails Committee as well as business and community partners such as Southwestern Public Health and the OPP to achieve committee's objectives.
- Collaborate with the Recreational Trails Committee on matters related to the promotion and support of active transportation initiatives
- To advise Council on the goals of the Cycling Coordinator.
