

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF INGERSOLL

BY-LAW NO. 90- 3464

A By-law to prohibit the obstruction of sidewalks and public highways in the Town of Ingersoll.

WHEREAS it is considered expedient to prevent obstruction to the free passage of pedestrians upon and along sidewalks in the Town of Ingersoll by persons congregating on the same;

AND WHEREAS municipalities are empowered by the provisions of Section 104 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 302 to pass by-laws and make regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS municipalities are empowered by the provisions of Section 210 (134) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 302 to pass by-laws for prohibiting and abating public nuisances.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Ingersoll enacts as follows:

1. No person shall congregate, stand or sit in any group on any public sidewalk or street in a manner which obstructs the free passage of people on foot moving along such sidewalk or street.
2. No person who has been directed by a Police Officer to move on or to cease standing or sitting on a public sidewalk or street shall continue to occupy or to sit or stand at such location.
3. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law shall, upon conviction, be liable to a fine of not more than One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars plus costs of \$3.75 for each such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
4. This by-law may be cited as "The Loitering By-law".
5. By-laws 84-3149, 86-3238, 89-3426 and 89-3442 are hereby repealed.
