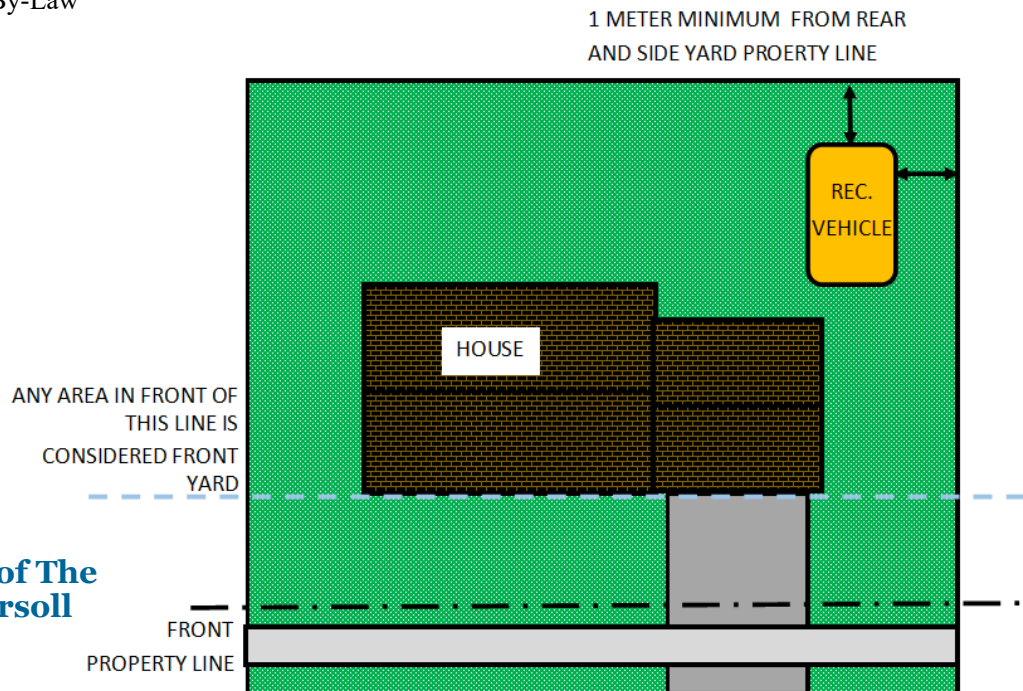


Parking of Recreational Vehicles over the Winter Months

By-Law 04-4160 :

- Recreational Vehicle is defined as: a registered vehicle which is one of the following: a snow mobile, a boat, a motor home, a trailer as defined herein or any unit designed to be towed by a motor vehicle for the purpose of transporting goods, materials or things
- 5.30.1.2 – The *recreational vehicles* must be stored within a detached or attached private garage or carport or in the rear yard or the interior side yard provided that such recreational vehicles is located no closer than 1 meter (3.3 ft) to the rear lot line or Interior side lot line.
- 5.30.1.3— The recreational vehicles may be parked or stored on a residential driveway in any front yard or exterior side yard between April 15th and October 15th. The recreational vehicle may be parked in a required parking space on the residential driveway. At any other time, such parking or storage is permitted only according to section 5.30.1.2
- Failure to comply may result in a fine of \$125 / day the Recreational Vehicles does not comply to the By-Law



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
