

Jim Fitzmorris Sr.

Hockey

Jim Fitzmorris was an Ingersoll native who grew up playing minor hockey. Over time, Jim became involved in coaching minor baseball, which he did for five years, as well as helping to coach the local girls' fastball. Most significantly, Jim's contribution to local sports is highlighted by his volunteer work spanning 30 years as a coach for Ingersoll Minor Hockey.

Jim acted as Vice-President of the Ingersoll Minor Hockey Executive from 1967 to 1971 before he assumed the role of Referee in Chief for Ingersoll Minor Hockey and initiated the formation of the Ingersoll Referee's Association.

For 14 years,—from the mid-70s until 1990—Jim coached the novice house league. His efforts were rewarded in 1988 when Jim received the Olympic Celebration medal for his contributions to minor hockey.
