Kieran Wilson was involved in a number of sports from a young age, but it was May of 2013 that he found his true passion in karate. Within the year he was winning trophies and medals at the local, provincial, and national levels. In total, Kieran collected 12 gold medals, 16 silver medals, and 15 bronze – not to mention another 8 trophies.

In 2015, Kieran began training to compete in elite divisions. His skill and determination paid off the following year when Kieran qualified for both the Ontario Summer Games and the World Martial Arts Organization World Championships in Costa del Sol, Spain. The latter competition resulted in a major win of 1 gold medal, 2 silvers, and 1 bronze. The discipline and respect that Kieran showed in karate was also reflected in his role as a leader and mentor for younger students who needed to learn the basic techniques of the sport.
