Information Letter to Residents

Pemberton Street Reconstruction – Phase 2

The Town of Ingersoll is proceeding with the reconstruction of **Pemberton Street from CN Railway to North Town Line East** as approved in the 2025 Capital Budget. The reconstruction involves the installation of new watermain, sanitary and storm sewers and new asphalt road surface including curb and gutter. A 2.4m-3.0m wide asphalt multi-use trail will also be constructed on the west side of Pemberton Street from Carnegie Street to North Town Line East, just west of the existing utility pole line.

The tender package for the project is currently out for bid with the tender scheduled to close on February 12th, 2025. Additional information letters to residents will be distributed once the contract has been awarded and the construction schedule of the successful contractor is finalized, however the Town is anticipating construction will occur between April and June of this year.

A set of construction drawings is available for public viewing at the Town of Ingersoll Municipal Office located at 130 Oxford Street, 2nd Fl, between the hours of 8:30am to 4:30pm, or by appointment, until tender close on February 12th, 2025.

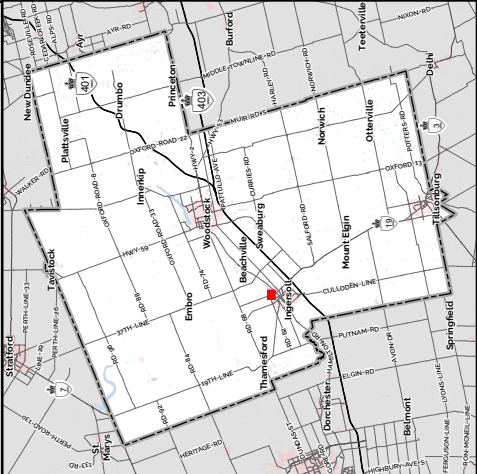
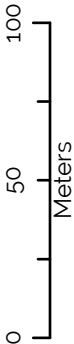
