ABOUT THE BUSINESS

With offices located at 387 Thomas Street and 180 Whiting Street in Ingersoll, ERTH Corporation is a municipally owned utility company that has been powering communities for more than a century. Through its regulated subsidiary, ERTH Power Corporation, the organization provides safe and reliable electricity to more than 25,000 customers across 15 communities in Southwestern Ontario. Beyond electricity distribution, ERTH also delivers technology solutions, utility construction, lighting, and energy services to utilities, municipalities, and commercial and industrial clients across North America.

A LEGACY ROOTED IN INGERSOLL

ERTH's story in Ingersoll dates back to the early 1900s, when the original Ingersoll Public Utilities Commission (PUC) was established. In July 2000, the Ingersoll PUC joined with six neighbouring municipal utilities to form Erie Thames Powerlines, now known as ERTH Power Corporation.

Today, ERTH remains municipally owned by nine Ontario municipalities and continues to grow while maintaining its commitment to local communities. Ingersoll remains central to that story, serving as the home of ERTH's Business & Operations Centre thanks to its strategic location within the utility's service territory and close proximity to Highway 401.

POWERING MORE THAN ELECTRICITY

While delivering safe and reliable electricity is at the heart of ERTH's work, the organization is equally committed to strengthening the communities it serves.

ERTH supports Ingersoll through local employment, sponsorships, charitable donations, volunteerism, educational initiatives, career fairs, and community events. One of its most significant recent contributions came in 2026, when ERTH donated \$45,000 to the Alexandra Hospital Foundation's One Chart = One Million Campaign through proceeds from its annual charity golf tournament.

Their commitment reflects a belief that strong communities are built through meaningful partnerships and long-term investment.



MILESTONES & INNOVATION

ERTH continues to invest in the future of both its organization and the communities it serves. This spring, the company officially moved into its new 57,000-square-foot zero-carbon Business & Operations Centre at 387 Thomas Street. Purpose-built to support future growth and modernization, the facility showcases the latest infrastructure and technology required to deliver reliable electricity across the region.

To celebrate the milestone, ERTH welcomed employees, customers, families, and community members to an Open House where visitors had the opportunity to tour the facility and learn firsthand about the people and technology behind the power that keeps communities running every day.

Looking ahead, ERTH Power is preparing for another exciting chapter. Pending Ontario Energy Board approval, the utility plans to expand through the proposed merger with Tillsonburg Hydro Inc. and acquisition of Westario Power Inc., growing its service area to approximately 60,000 customers across 31 communities in seven counties.



SERVICES BEYOND THE POLE

Many residents know ERTH as "Your Hometown Utility," but the organization offers far more than electricity distribution.

Through its non-regulated businesses, ERTH provides:

These specialized services support utilities, municipalities, and businesses throughout Ontario and beyond.

FUN FACT

ERTH isn't just helping communities transition to cleaner energy, they're leading by example.

Today, 19% of ERTH Power's fleet is electric or hybrid, and its new Business & Operations Centre operates without a natural gas connection. The facility features a 460-kW rooftop solar system along with 24 electric vehicle charging connections, demonstrating the company's commitment to sustainability and innovation.
