With two locations in Ingersoll, Tirecraft Ontario Inc. and Al's Tirecraft Ingersoll form one of Southwestern Ontario's most comprehensive tire and automotive service networks.

Together, their operations include a commercial tire distribution centre, a Michelin-certified retread plant (Canadian Treads), and a full-service automotive repair and tire retail facility, offering support for commercial fleets, agriculture, construction, and everyday drivers across the region.

A Longstanding Ingersoll Legacy

Al's Tirecraft Ingersoll first opened in 1987, growing steadily over the decades. The business expanded its footprint with a distribution centre in 2010, the relocation of their Ontario head office to Samnab Crescent in 2017, and the launch of Canadian Treads as a Michelin retread franchise in 2002.

In 2022, Tirecraft brought all supporting operations under one roof at the Ingersoll Street facility creating a fully integrated hub for continued growth, innovation, and customer service excellence.

Why Ingersoll?

The decision to grow locally was rooted in connection: staying close to home kept the business tied to the Burgessville community where many long-time team members lived and worked.

Ingersoll's proximity to the 401 corridor made it the ideal location for serving customers across Southwestern Ontario, and its rural surroundings naturally aligned with the agricultural and commercial markets Tirecraft has supported from the beginning.
